AMS 'significantly exceeds expectations'



AMS Report Card

- Amery Middle School has been rated FIVE-STAR and 'significantly exceeded expectations' in academic performance in Wisconsin for FIVE YEARS IN A ROW!
 - -Our score of 90.9 placed AMS 18th out of 377 middle schools in Wisconsin (Top 5%).
 - -Our Growth Score (how much students improved from previous year) was 94.4, placing AMS 7th out of 377 middle schools in the state (Top 2%).
 - -AMS has been in the Top 5% for Overall Rating and Top 2% for Student Growth FIVE YEARS IN A ROW.
- AMS has shown the highest middle-school math growth in the state for THREE consecutive years.
- AMS has had the highest middle-school reading growth in the state for TWO of the past five years.
 - AMS was designated a National Blue Ribbon School in 2024, placing it among the best schools in the U.S.!



Notes from the Principal's Desk

I hope you all enjoy the upcoming holiday season. We are excited to be closing out the first half of the school year, and we are pleased with how hard students have worked this year. In this newsletter, you will find some important dates coming up in the next two months that I want to bring to your attention:

Second Trimester

We are busy with the start of our second trimester; students have started their second set of classes and their third applied arts class.

First-Semester Reward Day

First-Semester Reward Day is scheduled for Friday, January 30, 2026. Students who do not receive more than five Level 2 and/or 3 infractions over the length of the entire semester are eligible for the off-campus reward options. We are still working on plans for Reward Day, and a form will be distributed to students soon. In the past, we have held events such as skating at the Amery Ice Arena, skiing or tubing at Trollhaugen, bowling, etc.

Freshman Registration Night

To help our students transition from 8th to 9th grade, we will be holding Freshman Registration Night the evening of Tuesday, January 27, 2026, at Amery High School. More information will be provided on this event at a later date. This registration session is for all 8th Grade students and their parents. In the past, parents and students had the opportunity to learn more about the high-school schedule, how the high school operates, what classes students must take, what classes students can choose from, and how the high-school credit system works. It is our goal for parents and students to leave Registration Night with a general understanding of what courses they must take now so they are better prepared to meet their personal goals and objectives. Students will also receive their high-school class registration forms at this meeting.

Parent-Teacher Conferences

Our second set of Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held Monday, February 9, from 4–8 PM and Thursday, February 12, from 1–8 PM. Again, the format for conferences will be in-person and remote options like we had this past fall.

Forward Exam

Students at Amery Middle School will take the Forward Exam the week of April 6-10. In addition, 8th Grade students will have testing April 13-14. More information about the Forward Exam will come at a later date.




