

End of 1st Term for Applied Arts Classes

The end of our 1st term for applied arts, science and social studies classes is Wednesday, Oct. 15. Students will be switching to their second-term classes following this date.

Parent Conferences

Just a reminder, parent-teacher conferences will be held on Monday, Oct. 6, from 4 to 8 p.m., and Thursday, Oct. 9, from 1 to 8 p.m. Conferences provide parents with the one-on-one time they may need to discuss their child's education. This year, conferences will be held remotely over the phone or in person. Parents will have to sign up for a time to meet or to receive a call. We are busy with students participating in Middle School Football, Cross-Country and Volleyball. We also have students involved in Drama Rama, Band, Choir, FFA and Student Leadership Activities. More information on Winter Sports and Storybook Theatre will be coming out soon.

I hope the rest of the school year continues to go as well as it has started. We are proud of how our students are performing at this time. Thank you for your continued support.



We want your child to be successful in school, and that means supporting and encouraging their whole development. While excelling in academic classes is important, students also need skills for learning challenges, making good decisions, handling strong emotions and getting along with others. This month during Warrior Time, we began Second Step® Middle School, a research-based social-emotional learning program designed to improve students' social-emotional skills. Second Step skills and concepts are designed to help students both in and out of school. These include:

Mindsets and Goals: Students learn how to develop a growth mindset and apply research-based goal-setting strategies to their social and academic lives. (*September/October*)

Developing a Positive Sense of Self: Students learn how to identify their guiding principles, explore different aspects of their self-concept and practice strategies to build confidence. This unit's content helps students view themselves positively and work toward becoming who they want to be. (October/November)

Thoughts, Emotions and Decisions: Students learn how to recognize strong emotions and in helpful thoughts and apply strategies to manage their emotions and reduce stress. (*December/January*)

Managing Relationships and Social Conflict: Students learn strategies for developing and maintaining healthy relationships, perspective-taking, and dealing with conflict. (*January/February*)

Bullying Prevention

Bullying is at its peak in middle school, and research indicates that taking proactive steps to address bullying will help reduce occurrences of it in our school. Throughout the month of October and November, your child will be discussing bullying during Warrior Time. The curriculum, Second Step, is designed to support your child in developing the knowledge and skills to help stop bullying. Students will learn how to recognize bullying in various contexts, how to use strategies to stand up safely to bullying and how to seek help if they or someone they know is being bullied.

We encourage students to report any instances of bullying they witness or experience to you and to trusted adults at our school. We also provide every student with the ability to anonymously report bullying or harassment via a link in their Warrior Time Google Classroom. We need student immunizations on file, OR a waiver for personal/religious/medical reasons on file, for school. Recommendations for 7th graders include Tdap (tetanus/acceullar pertussis and MenAWCY (mennigitis). If immunizations or current waiver are not on file, you will be communicated with by letter.

Dear Parents and Guardians.

The Polk County Health Department will be offering flu shots to students at Amery School District on 10/20/2025. To register your child, please complete the online form no later than 10/13/2025 at 11:59 PM. The Polk County Health Department will not be accepting walkins for this clinic. Flu vaccine will be available for students grades 4K-12. You will have the option to register your child for either the flu shot or the nasal mist. When signing your child up, please be sure to use their Legal Name (no nicknames).

If you have registered your child for the vaccine but no longer wish for them to receive it, please email polkcountycd@polkcountywi.gov with name and date of birth of your child and they will be removed from the registration list. Please note that students will not be signed up to receive vaccine unless they have been registered by a parent/guardian. If a student has been registered and receives vaccine before the school clinic, a cancellation request MUST be sent to Polk County Health Department.

The annual flu shot is one of the most effective ways to keep your child and their school safe during the flu season. To sign up your child, please complete the online registration form by clicking the link or scanning the QR code.
