BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education shall perform its' duties as a committee of the whole. Therefore, standing board member committees are not necessary.

Two types of advisory committees are appointed when deemed necessary by district needs or state and federal mandates. They are standing advisory committees and ad hoc advisory committees.

Advisory committees shall have no power to take action whatsoever, or to commit the Board or district to any course of action, except as specifically directed by the Board. These committees act in a study, investigatory and advisory capacity. All advisory committee recommendations must be acted upon by the Board.

Advisory committees shall abide by the state open meeting laws.

The Board President and district administrator shall be ex-officio member of all advisory committees.
