

PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AT RISK

The District recognizes that some students are “at risk” of not completing their public school education program. The District shall make a concerted effort to identify these students at the earliest possible time and establish a written plan of intervention to prevent premature exit from high school.

The Board encourages and permits the school guidance staff and principals to adjust the academic schedules of children at risk as necessary to meet the educational needs of each student.

Children at risk shall be identified by following administrative guidelines and procedures developed in accordance with state regulations.
