SUMMER SCHOOL

The district may offer students an opportunity to participate in summer school programs when there are identified student needs and interests as well as available resources. All summer school programs must have the approval of the Board.

Attendance on a regular basis is expected in order to ensure students receive the best educational benefits. In case of illness, family emergency or special family circumstances, a student is expected to make arrangements with the teacher in charge or the summer school director.

Counting Student Attendance:

Enrichment and Voluntary Remedial Classes

Because of the short duration of classes, if a student is registered for a class and attends at least one day, the student will be considered enrolled and counted.

Mandatory Remedial and Credit Courses

As soon as a student fails to meet the attendance requirements to receive credit, the student will be considered dropped from the course at that time.
