

STUDENT ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUG USE

No student shall violate any state or federal law regarding the possession, distribution, sale or use of alcohol beverages or controlled substances, or possess, distribute, sell, use or be under the influence of alcohol beverages or controlled substances, or be in possession of drug paraphernalia, while on school premises or while involved in any school-related activity. For purposes of this policy, alcohol beverages include all fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquor as defined by Section 125.02 of the state statutes and controlled substances and drug paraphernalia include all substances and equipment, products and materials as defined by Chapter 161 of the state statutes.

All students shall abide by this policy. Failure to do so shall result in disciplinary action that may include suspension or expulsion from school in accordance with Board policy and state law.

This policy shall be printed in student handbooks and other regular communications sent to students and their parents/guardians.
