

STUDENT POSSESSION AND USE OF WHEELED ACCESSORIES

Students may bring wheeled accessories, including, but not limited to, skateboards, roller blades, roller skates and sport shoes with a wheel housed in each heel for sidewalk skating (“Heelys”), into the school. Wheeled accessories brought into the school must be stored in lockers or in the school office in accordance with established building procedures and guidelines.

Students may transport wheeled accessories on a school bus provided the equipment is enclosed in a cloth bag.

Wheeled accessories may be used on school grounds. Each building Principal will establish regulations governing use in the school buildings and on the school grounds. Use of wheeled accessories on tennis courts and the track surface is strictly prohibited.

Students violating this policy shall be disciplined in accordance with established procedures.
