

STUDENT AID PROGRAMS

Families who claim that their financial condition is such that they cannot afford to pay for the required materials and supplies may request financial assistance from the district.

Before any financial assistance is given to such children, the parent/guardian of the child(ren) shall submit a statement of need to the district administrator for evaluation. If the family is on welfare, or is receiving aid from any of the welfare organizations, this fact should be noted on the statement. Requests for financial assistance shall be filed in the administration office. The parent/guardian of the child(ren) and the appropriate school(s) shall be advised of any action taken by the administration office.

Authorized school personnel shall report the names of indigent children to the agency administering relief programs for the county.
