

## STUDENT IMMUNIZATIONS

In accordance with state law, parents/guardians of children entering school must present evidence that the child has received basic and booster immunizations. Students who have not been fully immunized upon admittance to school must receive at least one dose of each vaccine required for their age/grade within 30 school days of admission. Exemptions may be obtained for medical, religious or personal conviction reasons. Medical waivers must be signed by a physician and all waivers must be signed by the student, if an adult, or the student's parent/guardian.

At specified times, all students may have the opportunity to receive immunizations at school. The school nurse shall maintain immunization records and shall notify students when it is time to receive immunizations.

In cooperation with public health agencies and officials, the Board shall develop and implement a plan to encourage compliance with state student immunization requirements. The plan shall be submitted to the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) annually.

It shall be the responsibility of the district administrator to ensure the district is in compliance with the requirements of state law.
