# Lien Elementary School Philosophy

At Lien, our 4K Legacy program believes that children learn best through child-led, investigative play. Play is familiarizing themselves with the world around them while exploring and testing their limitations.

We provide the preschool child with an educationally sound program in an atmosphere of warmth, friendliness, and freedom. We offer opportunities for exploration, experimentation, and inquiry while encouraging curiosity and expression of ideas.

We accept each child as an individual, helping the child grow in many dimensions. Our teachers plan a program that is developmentally appropriate, focusing on the "whole child" in terms of his/her social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development.



### Goals of the Lien 4K Program

In an environment where children's development is being nourished, we can expect children to grow in the following ways. These goals will help build the foundation for lifelong success:

- I can wait and be flexible.
- I can follow classroom rules with occasional reminders.
- I can meet my own needs (dressing, toileting, and with supplies)
- I can initiate, join in, and sustain positive interactions in small groups of 2-3 children.
- I can sustain a friendship with one child even though it may only last a short while.
- I can share materials.
- I can suggest solutions to social problems.




## **Printing**

### **Possible Investigation Topics**

We base our investigations around children's interests.

Seasons, Holidays, Cooking, Clothing, How things move,

Plants, Animals, Author Studies, Building

Our investigations will include developmental milestones from the following domains

- Social: how the child interacts with other children and adults and their environment
- Emotional: how the child feels about him/herself and the ways the child accepts and expresses personal feelings and ideas
- Cognitive: the thinking skills that are needed to catalog new information, formulate ideas and solve problems
- Physical: the awareness and control of the physical body that the child acquires through the five senses, rest, exercise, and nutrition

Development in these four areas occurs simultaneously. Together they form the foundation for life-long human development.
