

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

It shall be the goal of the School District of Amery to provide safe, efficient and economical transportation for all students who are eligible for such services.

The district shall provide transportation for all students living within the district who attend a district school and all students living within the district who attend a private school that is located within the district or not more than five miles beyond the boundaries of the district and reside within the school's attendance area.

The District Administrator is the individual responsible for the overall operation of the transportation program. The district's operation of the program shall be under the direction of the Transportation Supervisor who shall be directly responsible to the District Administrator.

Students attending private schools shall, while riding the bus, be subject to the same rules of conduct as students attending public schools.

Non-resident students attending Amery schools through Open Enrollment shall not be transported to or from a residence outside of the boundaries of the School District of Amery. Open Enrolled students will be allowed to use the School District of Amery's bus transportation, provided the student's parent/guardian transports the student to an established bus stop within the School District of Amery.
