USE OF MOTORIZED RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board of Education recognizes that the use of motorized recreational vehicles on school property presents a hazard to students, staff and others using school grounds, and presents the potential for legal liability in the event of accident or injury.

The Board, pursuant to its lawful authority, hereby prohibits the use of any and all motorized recreational vehicles on the grounds, parking lots, sidewalks and driveways of the District schools. The only exception is for snowmobiles traveling on designated trails.

All parking lots and driveways may be used by vehicles licensed for road travel at any time, according to posted regulations.

For purposes of this policy, motorized recreational vehicles shall include, but not be limited to snowmobiles, go-carts, trail bikes, all terrain vehicles and similar motorized vehicles not licensed to travel on public highways. Motorized recreational vehicles do not include those vehicles licensed to travel on public highways.

Incidents in violation of this policy shall be reported to the Amery Police Department.

Permission to use motorized recreational vehicles on school property may be granted by the Board of Education.
