

**YOUTH OPTIONS AND
HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA PROGRAMS**

Students enrolled in the High School may participate in Youth Options program or High School Equivalency Diploma program in accordance with state statutes and established guidelines and procedures. Students will be limited to a total of eighteen (18) postsecondary credits during their junior and senior years of high school.

If a student receives a failing grade or fails to complete (drops) the postsecondary course taken through the Youth Options program, the student will be responsible for reimbursement of tuition costs to the School District of Amery. Students who fail to provide reimbursement for a dropped or failed course as described above are not eligible for the Youth Options program.
