

**STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES**

Each student who rides a school bus shall be expected to behave in a manner which will make the ride safe and pleasant for passengers and the driver and which keeps the bus on schedule.

A student who does not behave properly shall be disciplined in accordance with established guidelines. The building Principal may suspend a student's bus riding privileges for a period of no more than three school days. If delinquent behavior requires a suspension of transportation privileges for more than three school days, the Board shall make such a ruling. Notification of parents/guardians and due process shall be in accordance with state law.

School bus rules and consequences for misbehavior shall be distributed and posted in the bus.
