We are excited to start our third trimester this week here at Amery Middle School. It's hard to believe that we are nearing the final part of the school year. In this final newsletter, I want to highlight a couple of upcoming events:

Forward Exam (Wisconsin State Test): Students will be taking the Forward Exam State Test during the month of April. All students will take a computerized Math and English Test and 8th grade students will also take a Social Studies and Science computerized test. Testing in the middle school starts on Tuesday, April 2 and ends on Friday, April 12. (Note additional information included in this mailing).

Spring Music Concert: We are excited to hold our Spring Band and Choir Concert on Thursday, April 18. We are looking at splitting up the concerts for size and time with the Middle School Choirs performing at 6:30 PM and the Middle School Bands performing at 7:30 PM. This concert will be held in the Amery Middle School Gym.

AMS Community Genius Expo: We have kicked off our annual project-based learning program called Genius Hour. During Genius Hour, students are able to research a project that they are passionate about (whatever they want to learn about). Students create a driving question to direct their project, students spend several weeks researching their topic and then create a presentation to showcase their work. We encourage parents to come and attend this event if they are able. More information will be sent to parents on this event in the near future.

8th Grade Youth Jam: Our annual eighth grade youth jam celebration is coming up on Friday, May 10, 2024. The 8th grade students will participate in fun outdoor activities at Jorgenson Field. We are exploring ways to improve this event with our 8th grade student leadership team.



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Voluntary Anxiety Screening

Amery Middle School is pleased to offer a voluntary stress and anxiety screening for 7th grade students. 


Babysitter Training certification (American Red Cross)

Rolling Poles Pole Vaulting Camps

For boys & girls entering grades 7-12 in fall 2024

In this camp we will learn and practice drills and techniques to help athletes with their pole-carry, run, plant, swing, and invert. Camp will include time on the runway doing full vaults as well as time on the track.



Camps will be run by coach Race Rolling who has been pole vault coaching for the last 11 years. Every year, he has had at least one athlete qualify for the WIAA State Track meet. Since taking the coaching position at Amery in 2022, his athletes have broken both the middle school and high school records as well as the women's Middle Border Conference record.

There will be 3 sessions of camp offered this summer - register for one, two, or all three. JUNE 18-20 from 12-4pm or JULY 16-18 from 8am-12pm or AUGUST 6-8 from 12-4pm. LOCATION: Amery High School track
