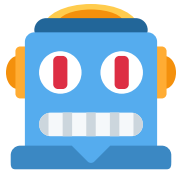

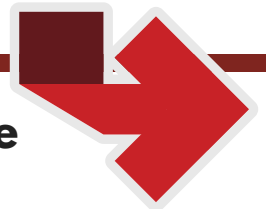

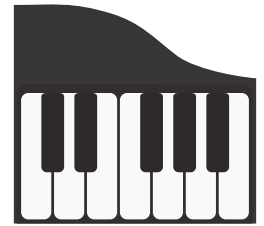

Snowmobile Safety: DNR

Any person born on or after 1/1/1985 and who has reached the age of 12, must have completed and received a snowmobile safety certificate in order to operate a snowmobile in WI.

Anyone 11 years of age or older is eligible to take the class and receive a safety education certificate; however, the certificate does not become valid until the child reaches 12 years of age.

Must be present for all 3 classes to pass the course.

Participants must have a DNR ID # by the first class.
