

SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

The legal basis for public education in the district is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Wisconsin Constitution. Public education is primarily a state responsibility and a local district's function.

The official name of this district shall be the "School District of Amery." It is classified as a common school district and includes the city of Amery and all or parts of the townships of Alden, Apple River, Balsam Lake, Beaver, Black Brook, Clayton, Garfield and Lincoln, Polk County; and the village of Deer Park and townships of Cylon and Stanton, St. Croix County.

The educational services of the district shall be organized as a program of instruction for early childhood, pre-kindergarten, grades kindergarten through 12 and Community Education. The district shall be operated as a single system by the Board of Education with direction from the district administrator.
