

SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

Special Board meetings may be held upon the written request of any Board member. If a member would like to request a special meeting, he/she shall notify the Board Clerk who, in turn, shall notify each Board member in writing at his/her home or personally in accordance with state law.

If all Board members are present and consent, or if every Board member consents in writing even though he/she does not attend, a special Board meeting may be held without prior notice.

Special Board meetings shall be open to the public. The public shall be informed of special Board meetings in accordance with state law and Board policy.
