PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

The public is invited to express their views on education-related decisions which have been made, or policies which have been adopted, by the School District of Amery Board of Education. Any District resident, District employee or guests invited by the Board may make comments about any decision, policy, or Board meeting agenda item. Such comments shall be made at the appropriate time, when recognized by the presiding Board member. The presiding Board member may limit the time for comments if necessary. Comments which are not about Board decisions, policies adopted by the Board, or are not about a Board meeting agenda item are disallowed. Political speeches which are not materially related to Board decisions, policies adopted by the Board meeting agenda item are strictly forbidden.
