

GRADING SYSTEMS

The School District of Amery shall evaluate student achievement in grades kindergarten through 12. To help evaluate student achievement, tests shall be given in each class during each grading period. These tests shall be scheduled during the regular class period and at such times that are appropriate to the materials being covered.

Specific grading systems for the various grade levels shall be developed by building principals. Virtual credits will not receive grade-weighted status.

The School District of Amery shall not discriminate in the methods, practices, and materials used for evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
