

SELECTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

The Board of Education, as the governing body of the district, is legally responsible for all instructional materials relating to the operation of the district. The Board, as a policy-making body, delegates the responsibility for coordinating the selection of and making recommendations for the purchase of instructional materials to the professionally-trained personnel employed by the Board. Such personnel shall select instructional materials in accordance with established guidelines.

The School District of Amery shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
