

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS

The interscholastic athletics program in the School District of Amery is recognized as an important part of the total educational program.

Students shall have the opportunity to participate in the interscholastic athletics program only if they are willing to assume certain responsibilities. Athletes must display high standards of behavior, exemplify good sportsmanship, show respect for others and abide by all eligibility and training requirements established by the Board and administration.

The District shall maintain membership in the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) and shall abide by all WIAA rules and regulations. Interscholastic athletics shall be limited to those activities involving WIAA member schools. Special permission may be granted by the Board for athletes to participate in other contests.

All students participating in athletics shall have a physical examination. Forms may be obtained at local doctors' offices.

The School District of Amery shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
