

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Any student being admitted to the School District of Amery must reside within the established boundaries of the district, except as otherwise provided. The administration shall verify the residence of children enrolled in district schools.

Parents/guardians of students admitted to district schools shall present immunization records as required by law.

The building Principal shall determine the level at which a student shall be placed. Specific school admission guidelines shall be established.

The School District of Amery shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
