

STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN VIRTUAL EDUCATION

The School District of Amery will offer virtual education to students enrolled in the Amery schools.

A virtual student is defined as a student who takes one or more courses approved by the School District of Amery. Computers and the Internet are used to access the curriculum of the course.

Amery's virtual education shall operate under all general policies with the following exceptions:

- A. Virtual education will be offered to students in Kindergarten through Grade 12.
- B. Students enrolled in Amery's virtual education will be considered students of the School District of Amery and will be subject to all state laws and Board policies.
- C. All virtual courses must be approved by the School District of Amery. College/University on-line courses will be subject to Youth Options guidelines.
- D. The School District of Amery will assign qualified advisors who will provide guidance and support for students enrolled in Amery's virtual education.
- E. Students enrolled in Amery's virtual education must be residents of the School District of Amery in order to participate in WIAA activities as well as co-curricular activities as listed in the co-curricular code.
- F. Students enrolled in Amery's virtual education shall be allowed to participate in school-sponsored field trips that are appropriate for their age and subject areas.
- G. Students enrolled in Amery's virtual education who fulfill all requirements for graduation will be eligible for a diploma from the School District of Amery.

The School District of Amery shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
