Guidelines for complying with the copyright law shall be made available to all staff members via the District's main website. Copyright guidelines shall be for video/film/sound recordings, print material, computer software and all emerging technologies. The following notice and warning shall be posted at each district copying machine: *"Notice: The Copyright Law Of The United States (Title 17 U.S. Code) Governs The Making Of Photocopies Or Other Reproductions Of Copyrighted Material. The Person Using This Equipment Is Liable For Any Infringement."*
